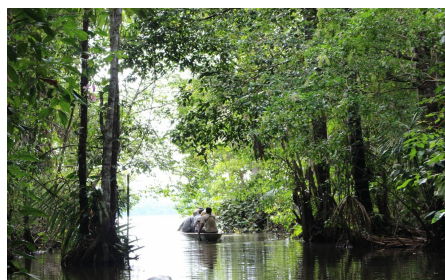

FULL ITINERARY

DAY 1 - WELCOME TO LIMA

On arrival you will be greeted at the airport by our local representative and transferred to our hotel in Lima.

For those arriving in time (hotel departure at 14:30), there will be an opportunity to explore Lima, Peru's vibrant capital. This guided city tour showcases a stunning blend of colonial architecture, historic pre-Columbian sites, charming residential neighborhoods, and lively shopping districts overlooking the Pacific Ocean.

Highlights include a visit to the magnificent Cathedral and the San Francisco Convent, both built in the 17th century. A standout experience of the tour is the exploration of the catacombs, Lima's ancient underground cemetery, offering a fascinating glimpse into the city's past.

Your Big Journey Tour Director will be on hand to discuss the rest of the trip with you at a welcome dinner together this evening.

DAY 2 - LARCO MUSEUM & PARACAS

We begin the day with a visit to the Larco Herrera Museum - always an entertaining and enlightening visit. Walking through the exhibition halls of the Larco Museum, the largest private collection of pre-Columbian art of the World, with our Curator makes the visit an inspiring experience. There is a wealth of information about the collection and the peoples that made the beautiful archaeological objects.

We enjoy lunch together before continuing along the city's lovely Pacific coastline through the enchanting neighbourhoods of San Isidro and Miraflores, departing Lima to head south to Paracas (approx. 4hrs drive).

We enjoy dinner together this evening.

DAY 3 - PARACAS & OPTIONAL NAZCA LINES FLIGHT

There is an opportunity today to purchase the optional excursion of a flight from Pisco Aerodrome, to pass over the giant, puzzling Nazca Lines.

The rest of the day will be spent at leisure, giving you the opportunity to enjoy the ocean views and the tranquillity of this coastal setting. However you choose to spend your day, we will meet together this evening over dinner.

Included meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Accommodation: La Hacienda Bahía Paracas

Optional extras: Nazca Lines Flight. Transfer to Pisco Aerodrome. From here, you will begin your overflight of the enigmatic Nazca Lines. Behold the incredible creative abilities of the ancient Peruvians as you discover one of humanity's greatest mysteries: geoglyphs and lines of colossal magnitude etched in the desert sands by the Nazca people. A monkey, a spider, a hummingbird, and more than 20 other figures occupying an area of approximately 190 sq. miles (500 km²), wait to be admired from above in an unforgettable experience (the flight is in a small plane and is an optional extra with additional cost).

DAY 4 - THE BALLESTA ISLANDS

Together today, we board a boat to the beautiful Ballestas Islands. The uninhabited Ballestas Islands are home to thousands of birds and mammals including penguins, sea lions, Inca terns, pelicans and dolphins. The spectacular Paracas National Reserve is a must for all wildlife lovers and we shall enjoy a guided tour to see and hear more about this very special place.

At the end of the day we return to Lima to prepare for tomorrow's flights to the Amazon rainforest.

DAY 5 - PUERTO MALDONADO & RESERVA AMAZONICA

This morning we travel back to Lima Airport for our flight to Puerto Maldonado.

***Each passenger is permitted to bring one piece of hand luggage on this flight, with a maximum weight limit of 10kg. You can leave your larger luggage at Inkaterra's office, where it will be securely stored. Upon your return to Puerto Maldonado, you'll easily retrieve it before continuing to the airport for your next destination.**

We begin our rainforest experience as soon as we arrive with a 45 minute boat ride along the Madre de Dios River to arrive at Inkaterra Reserva Amazonica lodge.

On arrival we will meet our local guide and then you are free to choose from the different included excursions available at the Inkaterra lodge during our stay.

Today we recommend a guided walk along the Trail system, into the Inkaterra Reserva Amazonica natural area, where you will discover the Amazon Basin. This trail offers an excellent introduction to the forest environment, winding past impressive trees such as the Shihuahuaco, and the strangely beautiful strangler fig, offering excellent opportunities for bird watching and observing exotic insects.

This evening the Twilight River excursion is not to be missed. Witness the transformation from a diurnal to a nocturnal world: animals and birds of the daytime give way to species specially adapted to the night. As you enjoy searching for nightjars, owls, capybaras and big caimans in their paradise, you will learn about their habits and habitat.

We will gather again for dinner this evening, served in the main dining room from 7.30pm. to 9.30pm. After dinner, you may retire early to your own cabaña, or join us to talk about the experience of life in the rainforest, as you listen to the intriguing sounds of the jungle at night.

DAY 6 - RESERVA AMAZONICA

Rest in bed or rise early — the choice is yours. Breakfast is served from 5.30am, for those who want to avoid the heat and enjoy nature to its fullest. A full buffet breakfast is served from 7:00am to 9.30am.

This morning we enjoy the Lake Sandoval excursion into the Tambopata National Reserve. Glide in a wooden canoe across a mirror-like lake, home to the endangered giant river otter, red howler monkeys, red-bellied macaws, anacondas, side-neck turtles and black caimans. Return to the Inkaterra lodge for lunch.

After lunch, consider the remarkable Inkaterra Canopy Walkway and Anaconda Walk. Ascending the first tower, 29 meters above the forest ground, you begin your encounter with the treetop realm. For more than a quarter of a mile, walk through the rainforest canopy on a suspension bridge network linking eight observation platforms. During this hour-and-a-half expedition, be on the lookout for bright toucans, woodpeckers, trogons, monkeys and the three-toed sloth. If you wish you may extend your excursion and appreciate the sunset from one of the towers.

After your descent from the Canopy, experience the Anaconda Walk for about 30 minutes along the 200-meter wooden bridge over the Aguajales swamps. In this lush eco system, you may observe the various species of amphibians, birds, mammals, abundant flora, trees and there is a possibility to see serpents of this flooded marshland. The walk finishes by returning to the lodge. Once at the lodge, enjoy the daily nature presentation in the Eco Centre.

DAY 7 - CUSCO AND THE SACRED VALLEY

After a restful morning, today we bid a fond farewell to the rainforest and are transferred to Puerto Maldonado Airport for our flight to Cusco. Upon arrival, we will be greeted and transferred to the Sacred Valley. The rest of the day is at leisure before dinner is served at the hotel.

DAY 8 - THE SACRED VALLEY AND PISAC

Today we visit Pisac, a picturesque town located 19.8 miles or 32km northeast of Cusco. Colourful fairs take place in Cusco every day. Here

merchants offer for sale all sorts of handicrafts, the most interesting of which are the textiles and ceramic goods such as ceremonial goblets called "Q'eros", plates, ashtrays, necklace and replicas of pre-Hispanic pottery. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant. Dinner will be enjoyed together at the hotel this evening.

DAY 9 - JOURNEY TO MACHU PICCHU

Today we enjoy a full-day visit to the awe-inspiring Historic Sanctuary of Machu Picchu.

We will be collected from the hotel at the scheduled time and transferred to Ollantaytambo train station to board the Vistadome-Observatory train. This scenic journey to Aguas Calientes is filled with breathtaking views of the Andes and the Urubamba River. Upon arrival, we take a short bus ride up the winding mountain road to the entrance of Machu Picchu, one of the New Seven Wonders of the World.

Rediscovered for modern times by Hiram Bingham more than a century ago, Machu Picchu continues to captivate visitors with its architectural brilliance, majestic setting, and mystical energy. Accompanied by our knowledgeable guide, we explore the citadel and learn about its fascinating history and significance to the Inca civilization.

Afterwards, we enjoy a delicious lunch at the Hotel's restaurant, before returning to Aguas Calientes. The remainder of the afternoon is free to relax and reflect on the day's incredible experiences before dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Important Information

For your Machu Picchu excursion, we recommend packing light and taking only what is necessary for the overnight stay in Aguas Calientes. The remaining luggage will be securely transferred by our staff to your hotel in Cusco, ready for your return and check-in.

*Train Baggage Allowance

Each passenger may bring one small bag or backpack (maximum 8 kg / 17.6 lbs, and total dimensions not exceeding 115 cm / 45 inches in length + height + width).

Please note that larger or heavier baggage cannot be taken on the train.

DAY 10 - EXPLORING MACHU PICCHU FURTHER AND RETURN TO CUSCO

Today we enjoy a second entrance to the magnificent citadel of Machu Picchu.

After breakfast, we take a short walk to the bus station for the scenic ride back up the mountain to the sacred site. Accompanied by our knowledgeable guide, we continue exploring this extraordinary Inca sanctuary — discovering new angles, hidden corners, and breathtaking viewpoints that reveal even more of Machu Picchu's mystery and grandeur.

Following our visit, we descend to the town of Aguas Calientes to enjoy a delicious lunch at Café Inkaterra, surrounded by lush cloud forest scenery.

In the afternoon, we board the Vistadome-Observatory train for our return journey through the spectacular Andean landscapes to Poroy railway station. Upon arrival, a private transfer takes us to our hotel in Cusco for an evening at leisure.

Accommodation: Palacio del Inka, Cusco

DAY 11 - CUSCO CULTURAL CITY TOUR

Today's tour visits the Fortress of Sacsayhuaman, a colossal structure built with huge carved rocks jointed with absolute accuracy. This is an astounding sample of Incan military architecture. We also enjoy the best view of the city of Cusco from atop Cerro Pukamayo (Red Peak), a

natural scenic overlook from which the outstretched arms of Cristo Blanco, a massive white statue of Christ, embrace the city in a benevolent gesture. Today we will also visit San Pedro Market, the Qoricancha (the Golden Temple) and Cusco Cathedral.

This evening we will have a farewell dinner together.

DAY 12 - FAREWELL TO PERU

Enjoy a full breakfast before transferring to Cusco Airport to meet the departure flights.
